## Time Commitment

## Training

A personal prayer life is important. The recruiting of volunteers and creating a prayer plan are pieces that the Camp Director will help with.

## Responsibilities

As the prayer coordinator you are charged with covering the entire camp in prayer. From the facilities and logistics through the gospel presentation and follow up with kids who make decisions. This can be done by using existing systems inside the church or by creating a new way to share prayer requests and needs.

1. Creating a plan on how to cover the week of camp in prayer.
2. Implementing the prayer plan throughout the church and among the volunteers who are praying for camp.
3. Working with the camp director on finding out prayer requests.
4. Creating a system to let volunteers know what to pray for.
5. Personally, pray for all aspects of the camp.
6. Prepare a plan for getting information to prayer volunteers after the week of camp, to celebrate Gods answers to their prayers.
